

CPI for Denver up in last half of 2007

The Consumer Price Index for all urban consumers in Denver rose 0.8 percent in the final six months of 2007, compared with the first half of 2007.

Transportation costs rose the most, up 3.6 from the first half of 2007. Recreation prices were up 2.9 percent, and food and beverage prices were up 1.4 percent. Medical care costs rose 1.1 percent. Housing prices fell 0.8 percent.
